Careers in Dairy and Agriculture

Lesson Introduction

In addition to working directly on a dairy farm, there are numerous careers available in dairy and agriculture. Today we are going to learn about many of these careers.

This lesson will match your interests to careers in dairy and agriculture suited for you. You will then analyze information to determine your favorite career in agriculture.

Lesson Objectives

- Students will be able to name at least three careers in dairy and agriculture.
- Students will be able to determine the primary responsibilities, education, recommended high school courses, annual salary, and projected growth of careers in dairy and agriculture.
- Students will be able to identify the career in agriculture that interests them most.


